AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF INTEREST ON LAWYERS TRUST ACCOUNTS (IOLATA) FUNDS FOR LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY OR LOBBYING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Massachusetts Interest on Lawyers Trust Accounts
- 2 Committee and the Massachusetts Legal Assistance Corporation
- 3 are hereby prohibited from disbursing or granting funds to any
- 4 entity or organization that engages in legislative advocacy and that
- 5 has legislative agents registered with the Secretary of State.
