AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CIRCUIT JUSTICES OF THE PROBATE AND FAMILY COURT; APPOINTMENT; EXPENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 211B, section 1 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by Chapter 206, section 6 of the Acts of 1988, is
3 amended by striking in line seven of the Official Edition, the
4 words, “three hundred and twenty” and inserting in place thereof
5 the words, “three hundred and twenty-six”.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 211B, Section 2 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by Chapter 379, section 70, is hereby
3 amended by striking in seventeen of the Official Edition the words,
4 “forty-three” and inserting the words, “forty-nine”.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 217, section 3C of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by Chapter 379, section 104 of the Acts
3 of 1992, is amended by striking in line one of the Official Edition
4 the word, “five” and inserting in place thereof the word “eleven”.

1 SECTION 4. Chapter 379, Section 69 of the Acts of 1992, is
2 hereby amended by striking in the second sentence the words,
3 “three hundred and forty-one” and inserting in place thereof the
4 words, “three hundred and forty-seven”.
