In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF THE COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS IN RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES, PENSIONS, AND ANNUITIES OF RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AND CERTAIN BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 102 (a) of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General
2 Laws shall be amended to read as follows:

3 The retirement allowance, pension or annuity of every former
4 employee of the Commonwealth or of any city, town, county,
5 district, housing or redevelopment authority, or the Massachu-
6 setts Turnpike Authority or of the Massachusetts Port Authority,
7 the Blue Hills Regional Vocational School system, or the Greater
8 Lawrence Sanitary District, or the Minuteman Regional
9 Vocational Technical School District, or of the spouse or other
10 beneficiary of any such former employee who is receiving a
11 retirement allowance, pension, or annuity shall, beginning July
12 first, nineteen hundred and ninety-four be increased by six
13 percent.
