AN ACT CONCERNING AMBULANCE SERVICES PROVIDED TO MEDICARE BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 111C of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 516 of the acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by
3 inserting after the fourth paragraph the following paragraph: —
4 The department shall require as a condition of granting or
5 renewing every license issued under this section that an ambulance
6 service which provides service to a beneficiary of health insurance
7 under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act shall not charge to
8 or collect from such beneficiary any amount in excess of the
9 amount approved for that service as determined by the United
10 States Secretary of Health and Human Services.
