AN ACT TO ENHANCE THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by deleting
2 section 89, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, and inserting
3 in place the following new section: —

4 Section 89. Any person, firm or corporation, or employee
5 thereof, and any representative, member or officer of such firm
6 or corporation individually, entering upon or engaging in the
7 business and work as defined in section eighty-one, without having
8 complied with this chapter, shall be punished by a civil fine of
9 not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) and not more than three
10 thousand dollars (\$3,000) or by imprisonment for not more than
11 three months, or both.
