RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE TESTING OF DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, consisting of three
2 members of the senate, seven members of the house of
3 representatives, the Secretary of the Executive Office of Elder
4 Affairs (or his designee), the Secretary of the Executive Office of
5 Public Safety (or his designee), the Registrar of the Department
6 of Motor Vehicles (or his designee), and six persons to be
7 appointed by the governor, one of whom shall be a representative
8 of an elder legal services organization, one of whom shall be a
9 representative of the American Association of Retired Persons,
10 one of whom shall be either a physician who is Board Certified
11 to practice ophthalmology in the commonwealth or is a licensed
12 optometrist, one of whom is a physician who is Board Certified
13 to practice psychiatry in the commonwealth or is a licensed
14 psychologist, and two of whom are consumers, is hereby
15 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study
16 of the testing and retesting of drivers of motor vehicles in the
17 commonwealth, including, but not limited to, the retesting of
18 persons licensed to operate a motor vehicle at specific time
19 intervals and the temporary suspension of a person's license to
20 operate a motor vehicle upon determination of temporary
21 incapacity from medical, physical or psychological impairments.
22 Said commission shall report the results of its investigation and
23 study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of

24 legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by
25 filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
26 on or before the last Wednesday in December nineteen hundred
27 and ninety-four.
