## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO LEAVE WITH PAY FOR CERTAIN INCAPACITATED  
FIRE FIGHTERS AND POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 111F of Chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 2 of chapter 646 of the Acts of 1977,  
3 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end of the first  
4 sentence the following: — “; provided, that if a disagreement  
5 arises between the physician or officer designated by the board  
6 and the personal physician, a medical specialist to be mutually  
7 selected by the appointed doctor and the personal physician shall  
8 be named to determine whether the incapacity still exists and his  
9 decision shall be binding on the appointing authority, further, if  
10 the appointing doctor and the personal physician are not able to  
11 agree upon a mutually acceptable specialist, a specialist shall  
12 instead be nominated by the Governor’s director of the office of  
13 human resources, who shall maintain a panel of medical specialists  
14 for such purpose”.
