AN ACT RELATIVE TO BOTTLE DEPOSITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 321 of Chapter 94 of the General Laws as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the definition of "Beverage" and inserting in place thereof the
4 following definition: —

5 "Beverage," soda water, or similar carbonated or non-
6 carbonated soft drinks, mineral water, beer or other malt
7 beverages, natural and reconstituted fruit juices, vegetable juices,
8 but not including alcoholic beverages other than beer and malt
9 beverages as defined in chapter 138, dairy products or wine.
