

By Mr. Nagle of Northampton, petition of William P. Nagle, Jr., for legislation to provide retirement credit for out of state service by teachers. Public Service.

AN ACT FURTHER IMPROVING RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR OUT-OF-STATE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3(4) of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by deleting the first sentence in the first para-
3 graph of said section and inserting in place thereof the
4 following:

5 Section 3 (4). Credit for Teachers for Out-of-State Service: —
6 Any member in service, or any member inactive on authorized
7 leave of absence of the teachers' retirement system, or any member
8 in service, or any member inactive on authorized leave of absence
9 of any other contributory retirement system who is employed in
10 a teaching or counseling position, or as a principal, supervisor or
11 president in a school or college, or employed in the department
12 of education as supervisor of teachers or of educational methods,
13 or employed as a member of the professional staff of a public
14 institution of higher education, who had rendered service in any
15 other state for any previous period as a teacher, counselor,
16 principal, supervisor, or superintendent in the public day schools
17 or other day school under exclusive public control and
18 supervision, or in a public academy, or as a teacher, counselor,
19 principal, supervisor, president or professional staff member in
20 a state normal school, state teachers college or like institution,
21 or other college under exclusive public control and supervision,
22 or in a public academy, or who was employed in a state
23 department of education as supervisor of teachers or of

24 educational methods, may, before the date any retirement
25 allowance becomes effective for him, pay into the annuity savings
26 fund of the system in one sum, or in installments, upon such terms
27 and conditions as the board may prescribe, an amount equal to
28 that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from
29 his regular compensation for such previous period, or most recent
30 portion thereof, as he may elect, had such service been rendered
31 in a public school of the commonwealth and had he been a
32 member of the teachers' retirement system during the period the
33 service was rendered; provided, that for such service which was
34 rendered prior to July first, nineteen hundred and fourteen,
35 payment shall be made equal to the regular deductions which
36 would have been withheld from his regular compensation if the
37 teachers' retirement system, as established by chapter eight
38 hundred and thirty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and
39 thirteen, had been in effect during the period the service was
40 rendered, and the interest in July first, nineteen hundred and
41 fourteen, shall be computed at the rate of three per cent.
