AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CRIME OF LEAVING THE SCENE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 21, of chapter ninety of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the period at the end of  
3 the second paragraph, and adding the following: — , vehicle, or  
4 property.

1 SECTION 2. Section 24 of said chapter ninety is hereby  
2 amended by striking in lines 10 through 13, the words “or  
3 whoever without stopping and making known his name, residence  
4 and the register number of his motor vehicle goes away after  
5 knowingly colliding with or otherwise causing injury to any other  
6 vehicle or property”.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 24 is further amended by inserting  
2 in line 50 after the word “person”, the words “, vehicle or  
3 property”.
