AN ACT RELATIVE TO YOUTHFUL FIREARM OFFENDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (6) of subsection (a) of section 10 of
2 chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official
3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subpara-
4 graph: —

5 The provisions of subsection (a) of section 10 shall be fully
6 applicable to any person proceeded against under section sixty-
7 one of chapter one hundred and nineteen and convicted under
8 section eighty-three of chapter one hundred and nineteen;
9 provided, however, that nothing contained in this section shall
10 impair, impede, or affect the power granted any court by chapter
11 one hundred and nineteen to adjudicate a person a delinquent
12 child, including the power so granted under section eight-three
13 of said chapter one hundred and nineteen. Any person who has
14 reached the age of fourteen, and who is adjudicated a delinquent
15 child under this section shall be committed to the custody of the
16 Department of Youth Services.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
