## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CALCULATION OF RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision (2) of section five of chapter 32 of  
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof  
3 the following paragraph: —

4 (c) The normal yearly amount of the retirement allowance for  
5 any member classified in Group 1, Group 2 or Group 4, who has  
6 worked on a part-time basis at any time during their service shall  
7 be calculated using their annual salary rate on a full-time basis,  
8 and pro-rating their creditable service to reflect the percentage of  
9 time actually worked. In all other aspects the retirement allowance  
10 shall be calculated in the manner set forth in paragraph (a).

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of  
2 the General Laws, any member who served on a part-time basis  
3 prior to the enactment of this act, and who retires subsequent to  
4 the enactment of this act, shall have his or her retirement  
5 allowance calculated in accordance with the provisions of this act.
