AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF THE COST OF SPECIAL EDUCATION
RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5A of the General Laws Chapter 71B, as inserted by
2 Chapter 351 of the Acts of 1981, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the second and third sentences of the first paragraph thereof
4 and inserting in their place the following sentences:— The school
5 committee shall pay the day program tuition rate as established by
6 the rate setting commission under sections thirty-one to forty-six,
7 inclusive, of chapter six A but in no case shall the school commit-
8 tee pay more than forty thousand dollars per student on account of
9 the total cost of the residential program established by the rate
10 setting commission. The commonwealth shall pay the entire
11 difference between the amount paid by the school committee and
12 the total cost of the residential program.
