AN ACT PROVIDING INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS TO CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS
HOSITING CORRECTIONAL FACILITES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 of Chapter 799 of the Acts of 1985, is hereby
2 amended by striking the first sentence and inserting in place
3 thereof the following: — “Said secretary is also hereby authorized
4 to expend twenty million dollars for the purpose of a grant
5 program to assist cities and towns to finance infrastructure repairs,
6 purchases, replacement, or construction which is necessitated by
7 the increased demand placed on such cities and towns as a result
8 of the existing state correctional facilities provided for in section
9 six or as a result of existing county houses of correction and a
10 regional house of correction provided for in section eight”.
