By Mr. Cabral of New Bedford, petition of Antonio F.D. Cabral and Joseph C. Sullivan that the Division of Standards be authorized to establish two or three year intervals for the renewal of certain certificates of registration. State Administration.

AN ACT ALLOWING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF STANDARDS TO SET UP REGISTRATION RENEWALS AT TWO OR THREE YEAR INTERVALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of Chapter 100A is hereby amended by adding to the
2 end thereof the following: Notwithstanding the preceding
3 sentence, the director may allow for issuance and renewal of
4 certificates of registration that are valid for two or three years from
5 the date of issuance, upon payment in advance of the required
6 registration fee for all years of such term; provided that the
7 director requires safeguards to assure continuous coverage during
8 such terms by the bond required by section 2, and that the director
9 requires provision for adequate notification of changes in the
10 information required by statute or by the director in the
11 application for registration.
