AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF A MOBILE TELEPHONE WHEN OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking in line six the words, "or mobile telephone."

1 SECTION 2. Section 13 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as
2 so appearing, is hereby amended by adding at the end of line 46
3 the following sentence: — No person shall operate a motor
4 vehicle who is using a mobile telephone unless use of such is
5 while said motor vehicle and the motor propelling it is brought to
6 a stop off the roadway.
