AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REPORTING OF CRIMES AGAINST STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15A of Chapter 22 of the General Laws as appearing
2 in the 1992 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph: —

4 Each city or town police department shall include within the
5 uniform crime report submitted to the department of public safety,
6 crime data compiled for crimes against students of institutions of
7 higher education that are committed within the city or town where
8 such school is located. Such information shall be taken from
9 incident/complaint report forms used by the city or town. Said
10 incident/complaint report forms shall, when applicable, indicate
11 whether the victim is a student attending an institution of higher
12 education that is located in the city or town in which the crime
13 occurred and the name of the school attended by such student.
