AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN PUBLIC LIBRARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter seventy-eight of
2 the General Laws or any rule or regulation to the contrary,
3 municipalities of populations of under five thousand shall be
4 authorized to employ librarians-in-charge, so called, as directors
5 of their public libraries, who have a minimum of three years
6 of concurrent librarian experience in order for the community
7 to qualify for any state grants.
