AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION  
AUTHORITY FARES FOR CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subsection (e ½) of section 5 of chapter 161A of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "older" in line 46, the
- 4 following words: — or a disabled veteran, as defined in clause
- 5 forty-third of section seven of chapter four, with a thirty percent
- 6 service connected disability or more.
