

HOUSE No. 4640

By Mr. Casey of Winchester, petition of Paul C. Casey and Charles E. Shannon for legislation to authorize the Department of Education to establish a sick leave bank for Mary Ellen McGreggs, an employee of said department. Public Service.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat it's purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave
3 bank for a certain employee of the Department of Education,
4 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law,
2 rule, or regulation to the contrary, the Department of Education
3 of the Commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed to
4 establish a sick leave bank for employee Mary Ellen McGreggs.
5 Each employee of the Department of Education may voluntarily
6 contribute one or more of his sick, personal or vacation days to
7 said sick leave bank for use by said Mary Ellen McGreggs.
