

HOUSE No. 4664

By Mr. Sullivan of Abington, petition of Michael J. Sullivan (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Abington to issue an additional license for the sale of wine and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises to James J. Stone, d/b/a Stone Enterprises, Inc. Government Regulations. [Local approval received.].

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ABINGTON TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF WINE AND MALT BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifteen
2 of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the
3 licensing authority of the town of Abington is hereby authorized
4 to issue an additional license for the sale of wine and malt
5 beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the provisions
6 of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight to
7 James J. Stone, d/b/a Stone Enterprises, Inc. Said license shall
8 be subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and
9 thirty-eight; and provided further, the total number of licenses for
10 the sale of wine and malt beverages not to be drunk on the
11 premises that the local licensing authority may issue shall not be
12 increased by this legislation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be in effect upon its passage.
