AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN MIRRORS ON TRUCKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 fourth paragraph the following paragraph:—

4 Every heavy commercial vehicle shall be equipped with a
5 mirror placed on its front left fender, so placed and adjusted as to
6 afford the operator a clear, reflected view of the highway to the
7 rear and left side of the vehicle. For the purpose of this section
8 heavy commercial vehicles shall be defined as those in excess of
9 two tons used for transportation of goods, wares and merchandise.
