AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CERTAIN FIREARMS DURING THE HUNTING SEASON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 70 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 last paragraph and adding the following paragraph:—

4 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the director may
5 authorize the use of primitive firearms or shotguns with a rifled
6 bore for hunting during any period when deer may be hunted by
7 means of a firearm under rules and regulations promulgated in
8 accordance with Section 5.
