

By Mr. Businger of Brookline, petition of John A. Businger relative to authorizing the State Retirement Board to grant a pension to Arlenn Officer. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE RETIREMENT BOARD TO GRANT A PENSION TO ARLENN OFFICER.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately retire Arlenn Officer,
3 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
4 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary and in order to promote the public good, the state
3 board of retirement is hereby authorized and directed to retire
4 Arlenn Officer, a psychologist III, in the department of mental
5 health due to total and permanent incapacitation for further
6 service. The annual retirement allowance payable to Arlenn
7 Officer hereunder shall be fixed in an amount equal to seventy-
8 two percent of the regular rate of compensation she would have
9 been entitled to receive had she continued in full time service as a
10 psychologist III in the department of mental health. Said Arlenn
11 Officer shall be entitled to and shall receive all annual cost of
12 living adjustments to her annual pension granted under the
13 provisions of section one hundred and two of chapter thirty-two of
14 the General Laws or any other general or special law.
