AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NORFOLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section  
2 fourteen of chapter thirty-four of the General Laws or any other  
3 general or special law to the contrary, within thirty days after the  
4 effective date of this act, the county commissioners of Norfolk  
5 County are hereby authorized and directed to convey by deed or  
6 deeds a certain parcel of land and the buildings thereon in the  
7 town of Dedham known as the old Norfolk County Jail, located  
8 on Village Avenue, to the division of capital planning and  
9 operations, said parcel to be more particularly described in a plan  
10 to be prepared by said division and recorded in the Norfolk  
11 registry of deeds.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
