AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS AT CERTAIN STATE UNIVERSITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 9 the following section: —

3 Section 9A. The higher education coordinating council shall con-
4 duct a study of the feasibility and costs associated with the develop-
5 ment and implementation of co-operative education programs for all
6 public colleges and the university of massachusetts system. Said
7 study shall be completed by December thirty-first, nineteen hundred
8 and ninety-four with copies submitted to the clerks of the house and
9 senate and to the joint committee on education, arts and humanities.
