## AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE OF REASONABLE ASSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 42 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by adding at the end of the second paragraph the following  
3 paragraph: —

4 For the purposes of this section, an employee-at-will is defined as  
5 one whose dismissal is not conditioned upon a demonstration of just  
6 cause.
