The committee on Transportation, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1511) of Lucile P. Hicks and Stephen W. Doran for legislation relative to development at Laurence G. Hanscom Field, the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1525) of Robert E. Travaglini for legislation relative to the granting of special permits for private landing areas, the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1677) of Robert A. Durand for legislation to clarify the authority of the Massachusetts Aeronautics Commission and cities and towns with respect to the maintenance of runway clear zones at airports that are open to the public, the petition (accompanied by order, House, No. 1786) of Robert A. DeLeo and Robert E. Travaglini relative to the appointment of a joint special committee to make an investigation and study of the siting of a second major airport in the Commonwealth, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2170) of Forrester A. Clark, Jr., for legislation to provide for revenue financed safety improvements at certain public airports, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3323) of Stephen W. Doran, Pamela P. Resor, Marianne Brenton and Robert A. Havern relative to the powers of the Hanscom Field Advisory Commission, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4969), ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Transportation be authorized to
2 sit during recess of the General Court to make an investigation and
3 study of Senate documents numbered 1511, 1525 and 1677; and
4 House documents numbered 1786, 2170 and 3323, relative to the
5 Massachusetts Aeronautics Commission.

6 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its
7 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
8 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
9 into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of
10 Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in December, nine-
11 teen hundred and ninety-four.
