AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF CERTAIN BURIAL EXPENSES BY THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To settle a moral obligation, the city of Boston
2 acting by its mayor and city council, may expend an amount not
3 to exceed ten thousand dollars to reimburse the heirs of late
4 Rev. Accelynne Williams for the expenses of his funeral and
5 burial.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
