AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave bank of
3 ra certain employee of the department of revenue, therefore it is
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the imme-
5 diate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the department of
3 revenue and the probate and family court department of the trial
4 court of the commonwealth are hereby authorized and directed to
5 establish a sick leave bank for Rhea Lindstedt, an employee of the
6 department of revenue and former employee of the trial court of
7 the commonwealth. Any employee of said department of
8 revenue or said trial court may voluntarily contribute one or more
9 of his sick, personal, or vacation days to said sick leave bank for
10 use by said Rhea Lindstedt.
