AN ACT DECLARING SMITH VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURAL HIGH SCHOOL A REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose which is to provide certain funds for the Smith
3 Vocational Agricultural High School, this act is hereby declared to
4 be a public emergency law, necessary for the immediate preserva-
5 tion of the public convenience. This act, therefore, will take effect
6 upon passage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, for the purposes of
3 Sections Sixteen C and Sixteen D of Chapter Seventy-One of the
4 General Laws, Smith Vocational Agricultural High School shall
5 be considered a regional school district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
