To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

I am filing for your consideration the attached legislative proposal, entitled, "An Act Relative to the Appointment of a Certain Police Officer in the Town of Marblehead," pursuant to the provisions of Article II, Section 8, Paragraph 1, Clause (2) of the Articles of Amendment to the Constitution, as amended by Article LXXXIX.

Representative Peterson, Senator Boverini, and the Marblehead Board of Selectmen have requested that I file this legislation. The bill will permit a former Marblehead Police Officer to be re-appointed to the department without being required to complete an eighteen week training program as required by 550 CMR 3.02 (9) (c) in the case of interruptions of service of three or more years.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A CERTAIN POLICE OFFICER IN
THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section ninety-six B of
2 chapter forty-one of the General Laws, John Blaisdell may be
3 appointed to the police department of the town of Marblehead and
4 may exercise police powers in said police department without
5 being required to be assigned to and satisfactorily complete a pre-
6 scribed course of study at a regional or municipal police training
7 school, approved by the Massachusetts criminal justice training
8 council.
