AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCURRING INDEBTEDNESS IN THE TOWN OF IPSWICH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
- 2 the contrary, the action by which the town of Ipswich at its annual
- 3 town meeting on April fourth, nineteen hundred and ninety-four
- 4 voted to amend chapter II of its general by-laws by deleting section
- 5 six and inserting in place thereof a new section six is hereby rati-
- 6 fied, validated and confirmed.
