

Accompanying the eighth recommendation of the Department of Correction (House, No. 49). Human Services and Elderly Affairs.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF PRISONERS TO PRISON CAMPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 83A of chapter 127 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 195 of chapter 706 of the acts
3 of 1975, is further amended by striking out the following words: —
4 “including male prisoners sentenced to life who have served
5 twelve years, except those serving a sentence for life for first degree
6 murder”.

1 SECTION 2. Section 83B of chapter 127 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 172 of the acts of
3 1972, is hereby further amended by striking out the following
4 words: —
5 “including the male prisoners sentenced to life who have served
6 twelve years except a prisoner serving a life sentence for first degree
7 murder, or a sentence imposed for violation of sections twenty-
8 two, twenty-three and twenty-four of chapter two hundred and
9 sixty-five and for attempts to commit a crime referred to in said
10 sections”.
