AN ACT TO FURTHER DEFINE EMPLOYER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149, Section 1 is amended to define "Employer" as
2 follows: "Employer," as used in this chapter shall include any
3 person, corporation, partnership, firm or company, including the
4 commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof who engages
5 the services of another or whoever shall act in the interest of such
6 employer directly or indirectly; except in those sections of this
7 chapter in which "employer" is specifically defined.
