AN ACT RELATIVE TO WAGES UNPAID BY AN EMPLOYER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 149, Section 148 shall be amended by deleting from the

- 4 more than six days from the termination of the work week in which
- 5 such wages were earned by the employee.”
