### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING NONRESIDENTS RIGHT TO CARRY FIRE-ARMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 131G of Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, and inserting in place  
3 thereof, the following new sentence: — Any person who is not a  
4 resident of the commonwealth may carry a pistol or revolver in or  
5 through the commonwealth; provided, that such person is a resi-  
6 dent of the United States and has a permit or license to carry  
7 firearms issued under the laws of any state, district or territory  
8 thereof which has licensing requirements which prohibit the issu-  
9 ance of permits or licenses to persons who have been convicted of a  
10 felony or who have been convicted of the unlawful use, possession  
11 or sale of narcotic or harmful drugs.
