RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE EQUALIZATION OF EDUCATIONAL SERVICES OF THOSE THAT ARE VISUALLY SENSORIALLY BLIND, WORD BLIND, PARTIALLY WORD BLIND OR LETTER BLIND.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of
3 representatives, the commissioner of education or his designee, six
4 persons appointed by the governor, one of whom is a person
5 trained in the education of the sensorially deprived, is hereby
6 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study of
7 feasibility of providing equalization of educational services for the
8 handicapped who are visually sensorially blind, word blind,
9 partially word blind or letter blind.
