AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION OF PHARMACISTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding  
2 to section 24A, as most recently amended by section 23 of chapter  
3 684 of the acts of 1972, the following paragraph: —

4 “Beginning January 1982, every registered pharmacist and every  
5 registered assistant pharmacist registered under the provisions of  
6 this chapter shall, as a condition of the renewal of his or her  
7 registration, present to the board with his or her registration blank,  
8 on such form as the board may provide, evidence satisfactory to the  
9 board that in each year, since the last renewal of his or her registra-  
10 tion, he or she attended one or more educational conferences or  
11 pursued an educational program in conformity with such require-  
12 ments relating thereto as the board may from time to time establish  
13 by appropriate regulation.”
