AN ACT TO INCREASE PLANNING BOARD INVOLVEMENT IN REGIONAL PLANNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of Chapter 40B of the Massachusetts General Laws,
2 as amended by Chapter 849 of the Acts of 1970, and Chapters 163
3 and 706 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by inserting
4 after the second sentence the following sentence: — The planning
5 board of each city and town of the metropolitan area planning
6 district shall appoint an alternate representative who may attend
7 council meetings but shall act only in the absence of the
8 representative.
