AN ACT TO INCLUDE TRAINING OF CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AS PART OF THE INSTRUCTION IN HEALTH EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 753 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in space
4 thereof the following sentence: —

5 Instruction in health education shall include, but shall not be
6 limited to: consumer health, ecology, community health, body
7 structure and function, safety, nutrition, fitness and body dynam-
8 ics, dental health, emotional development, and training in the
9 administration of first aid, including cardiopulmonary
10 resuscitation.
