

By Mr. Nagle of Northampton, petition of William P. Nagle, Jr., relative to the granting of additional package store licenses. Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF ADDITIONAL PACKAGE STORE LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 138 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 17A of said chapter, the follow-
3 ing new section: —

4 *Section 17B.* Additional licenses.

5 The local licensing authority of a city or town which granted
6 seasonal licenses under section fifteen prior to January the first,
7 nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, and which accepts this section
8 by a majority vote of a town meeting if a town, or by majority of
9 the city council if a city, is hereby authorized to grant, in addition
10 to, and irrespective of any limitation of the number of licenses
11 contained in section seventeen, but subject to all other provisions
12 of this chapter, additional licenses under section fifteen.

The eighth part of the document is a list of tables, which are used to present data in a clear and concise manner.

The ninth part of the document is a list of figures, which are used to illustrate the data presented in the report.
