AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MANDATORY IMPRISONMENT FOR CERTAIN DRUG VIOLATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 33 of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 102 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further
3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 No person knowingly or intentionally shall possess a stolen,
5 altered, or forged prescription. Whoever violates any prison of this
6 paragraph and receives a house of correction or state prison sen-
7 tence imposed under paragraph C shall not have the sentence
8 suspended nor shall any person so convicted be eligible for proba-
9 tion, parole or furlough or receive any deduction from his sentence
10 for good conduct.
