AN ACT TO REIMBURSE THE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR COSTS INCURRED AS A RESULT OF THE ENACTMENT OF CHAPTER 459 OF THE ACTS OF 1979.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 459 of the Acts of 1979 is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting following the words: — “when a sign erected at such
- 3 intersection giving notice thereof, “the following sentence: —
- 4 The cities and towns shall be reimbursed in full by the Common-
- 5 wealth for all costs resulting from this section including the con-
- 6 struction, placement and maintenance of signs.
