

HOUSE No. 1565

By Mr. Hermann of North Andover, petition of Joseph N. Hermann that the excise imposed on registered motor vehicles shall not apply to certain motor vehicles leased by political subdivisions. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE EXCISE IMPOSED ON REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES LEASED BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of the fourth paragraph of section one of
2 chapter 60 A of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 576 of
3 the acts of 1978, is hereby amended by striking out the same and
4 inserting the following sentence:— The excise imposed by this
5 section shall not apply to motor vehicles or trailers owned and
6 registered by the commonwealth or any political subdivision there-
7 of, or leased by a political subdivision thereof for a period of twelve
8 consecutive months, or to motor vehicles or trailers owned and
9 registered by a corporation whose personal property is exempt
10 from taxation under clauses Third and Tenth of section five of
11 chapter fifty-nine.
