AN ACT EXTENDING DEDUCTIONS ON PROPERTY TAX LEVIES AND EXPENDITURES OF CITIES, TOWNS OR OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNITS DEPENDENT ON THE PROPERTY TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 151 of the acts of 1979, section 2, is amended by adding
2 in the paragraph defining "levy", subsection (j) increased energy
3 costs since January 1, 1979; (k) costs of extra-curricular athletic
4 programs; and, (l) amounts necessary for the purchase of text-
books.
