AN ACT ELIMINATING THE FILING DATE FOR BILLS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE GENERAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 A legislator may file petitions for consideration by the general
- 2 court during the first sixty days of the legislative session.
