AN ACT DIRECTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO APPROVE A CERTAIN SCHOOL RENOVATION AND CONSTRUCTION IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,
2 the City of Lawrence shall be eligible for sixty-five percent of the
3 approved cost of school construction and renovation and any
4 other benefits authorized by the applicable provisions of chapter
5 six hundred and forty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and
6 forty-eight, as most recently amended by the provisions of chapter
7 three hundred and two of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-
8 six, and the board of education is hereby authorized and directed
9 to approve, as set forth in section eight of said chapter six hundred
10 and forty-five, as so amended, the application submitted by the
11 City of Lawrence in nineteen hundred and seventy-eight for such
12 construction. The said board is hereby further directed to certify to
13 the comptroller of the amounts due on said construction and
14 renovation, including interest, and the state treasurer shall pay to
15 said City said amounts in accordance with the applicable provi-
16 sions of section nine of said chapter six hundred and forty-five, as
17 amended by sections five and six of said chapter three hundred and
18 two.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
