AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE STATE PLUMBING CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, or
- 2 any provision of the state plumbing code to the contrary, a licensed
- 3 journeyman plumber in business, may employ his son or daughter
- 4 to work for him, and said son or daughter may gain apprentice
- 5 credit under their father's license.
