AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF APPRENTICE PLUMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3A of Chapter 142 as most recently amended by Section
- 2 5 of Chapter 843 of the Acts of 1977 is hereby further amended by
- 3 inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph: —
- 4 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a journeyman
- 5 plumber may employ a person as an apprentice if said journeyman
- 6 has become totally disabled, as determined in accordance with
- 7 federal law, and said person is a member of the journeyman's
- 8 immediate family, provided however said person works under the
- 9 direct supervision of said journeyman.
